The mission of The Founders Fund. Inc. is to provide financial assistance to young men and women from Collier County as they pursue an undergraduate degree. Recipients are selected on the basis of need and merit from eleven area high schools.

The Founders Fund was created in 1991 by the Founding Golf Members of The Club Pelican Bay and is classified as a 501 (c) (3) non-profit, tax-exempt charitable organization.

The Founders Fund is supported by Golf and Social Members of The Club Pelican Bay, as well as many corporate sponsors which include prominent local and national businesses that are very generous in their support of The Founders Fund. Income from reserve assets and fundraising activities support annual scholarships that now total over \$200,000 per year. Fund scholarship awards have totaled more than \$2.6 million dollars since the beginning of the Fund.
